Progress to Date (July 2015)

The number of women who have completed each stage of the study by the end of July 2015 is as follows:

Rotunda Hospital

Survey 1 (early pregnancy)	1839
Survey 2 (3 months postpartum)	1474
Survey 3 (6 months postpartum)	1309
Survey 4 (9 months postpartum)	1113
Survey 5 (12 months postpartum)	944

Later surveys come in as women continue in the study and we love getting your postnatal surveys as they tell us how you are getting on in your life as a new mother.

Galway Hospital

Over 300 women have been recruited in Galway and follow-up is going very well with more than 90% of women completing the 3-month postpartum survey.

Coombe Women and Infants University Hospital

We are delighted to say that the MAMMI study is starting in the Coombe Women and Infants University Hospital in September 2015.
